Script for Research Follow Up Interviewer to contact a participant about a phone or Zoom exit interview:

“My name is _____ and I am on the UW research team for the PCAP study.
(research exit interviewer)

You gave your PCAP worker permission for me to get in touch with you. May I talk with you for just a few minutes?

When you started PCAP, the clinical supervisor interviewed you and told you after three years we would like to interview you again. You have been in PCAP now for three years. I am calling you to give you information to help you decide if you want to be in the study. If you decide to be in the study, I would interview you over the phone or by Zoom video for about two hours and ask you to fill out a form. I’ll pay you \$20 or give you a \$20 gift card for taking part in the study. You don’t have to be in the study if you don’t want to. You won’t be penalized in any way or lose any benefits if you decide not to be in the study or skip questions. All study information is confidential.

If you think you’re interested, I’ll mail you a consent form that explains the study, along with a stamped addressed envelope. After about a week, I will call you to answer any questions you may have about the study. If you decide to be in the study, I will ask you to sign the consent form and send it back to me. You can also tell me if you want to be in the study over the phone or by Zoom. Then we will schedule a time when it is convenient for you to do the interview.”

Do you have any questions about this?”
Give client opportunity to ask any questions.

“Do you think you’re interested in doing the study interview?”

If the participant says no:
“I understand. Thank you for your time.”
