**Script for program staff (clinical supervisors or case managers) to inform participants of the follow-up interview:**

“When you started PCAP, \_\_\_\_\_ interviewed you and told you after about three  
(clinical supervisor name)

years the UW researchers would like to interview you again. You have been in PCAP now for about three years. Do you have a few minutes to talk about this?

The researchers would like to give you information to help you decide if you want to participate in the study exit interview. If you decide to take part, a researcher will interview you for about two hours, either in person or over the phone or via Zoom video. The researcher will ask you to fill out a form. You will receive \$20 or a \$20 gift card for taking part in the interview. You don’t have to be in the study if you don’t want to. You won’t be punished in any way if you decide not to take part.

If you agree, I can schedule a time to pick you up and bring you to the PCAP office to talk with one of the researchers. If it’s not convenient for you to meet at our office, we can go to a place that’s better for you, as long as it’s private. If you do the interview in person or over the phone, I can take care of your child(ren) while you talk to the researcher.”
